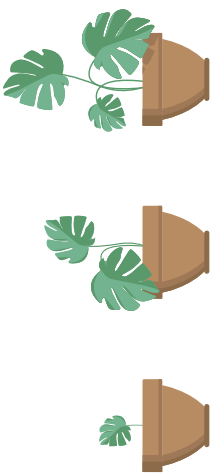

## 2022 CAMPAIGN RESULTS:

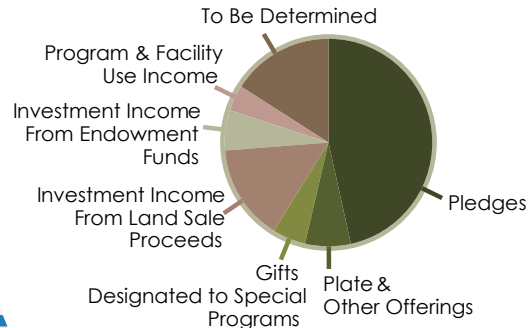

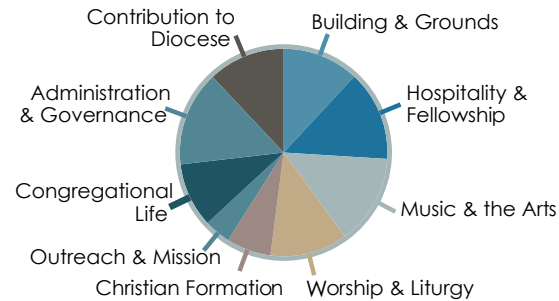

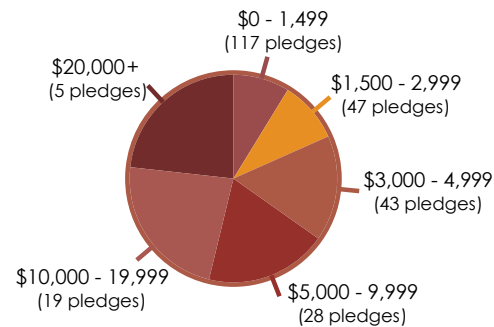
### WHERE DOES THE MONEY COME FROM?
