

Total Amount Pledged: \$1,004,438




### WHERE DOES THE MONEY COME FROM?

### **A History of Service**

We are expanding our Family Ministry, Evangelism and Outreach programs, rebuilding our Music Ministry, restarting our children's choir, offering free concerts, and partnering with Voices of Our City and Villa Musica. We are exploring new ways to make use of building for the common good of our neighborhood and city. We can do more!
