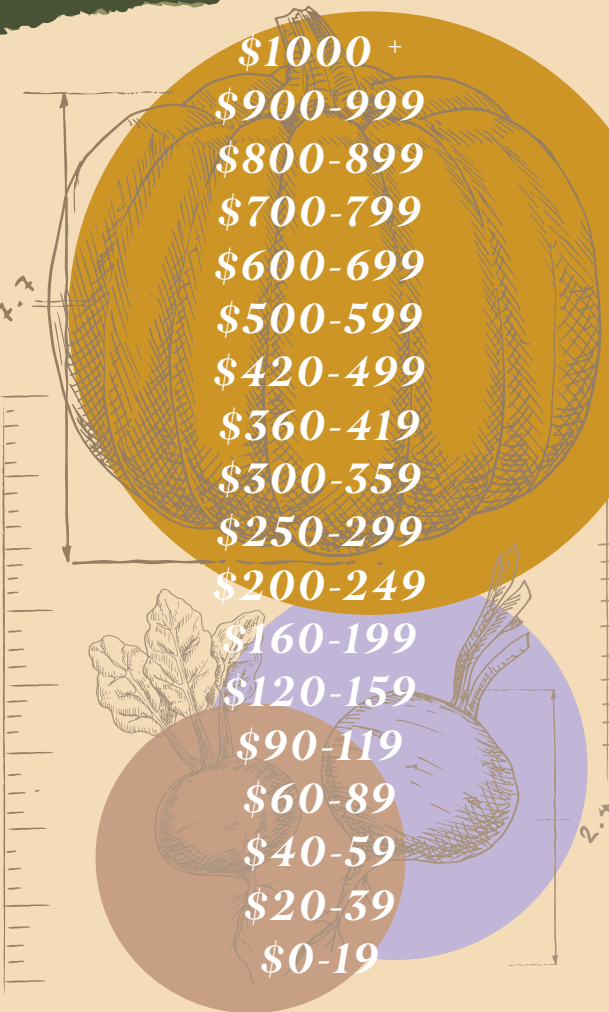

Find the amount that matches your current monthly giving and prayerfully consider increasing one step.



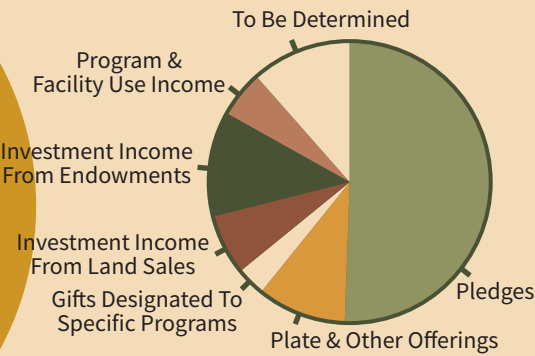
2024 Campaign Results

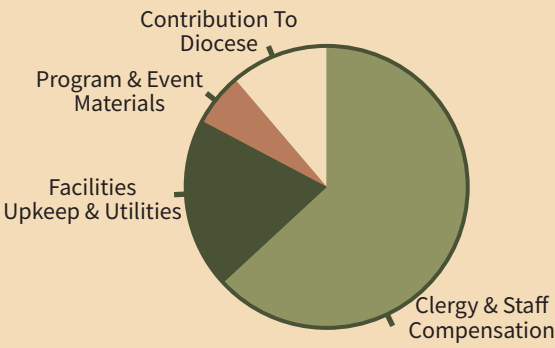

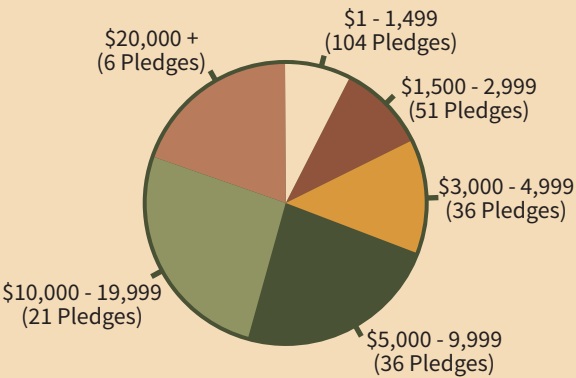
Where does the money come from?

Pledge income by pledge size:



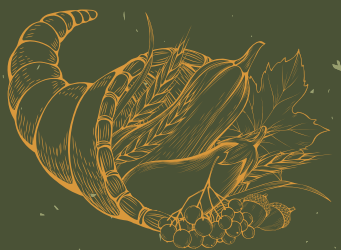
Proportional Giving And Why It's Important!

- The key to Proportional Giving is to think in terms of percentage, not flat amounts.
- While we don't presume to set a percentage or amount for each other, the New Testament does teach us a general principle that we should give in proportion to what God has given us.
- God gives, values, and loves us at a rate of 100%. We get to choose what percentage of our blessings return our gratitude.
- Whatever proportion we decide on, we need to give willingly and cheerfully.
- Proportional Giving provides a regular chance to contemplate the desires of our hearts, to make sure we're not slipping into greed.

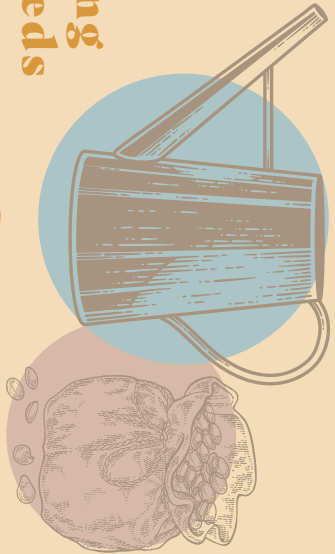

The Seeds

- Invited visitors into the cathedral for at least 18 concerts
- Welcomed neighbors to experience hospitality and fellowship at Movie Nights, Game Nights, the Community Dinner Project, Showers of Blessings, and Trunk or Treat
- Took prayer and reconciliation across the city, offering Ashes-to-Go to 547 people where they were
- Lifted up marginalized communities around us by hosting events like Light Up the Cathedral for Pride and Shine a Light Shabbat Dinner
- Provided office, meeting, and programming space for community organizations including:
 - Twelve-Step Programs
 - Black Xpression
 - Dignity Showers
 - The San Diego Creative Arts Project
 - The Regional Task Force on Homelessness
 - Sound Meditation Presents
 - transcendance
 - Pride Popup Orchestra
 - The Miller Music Academy
 - Voices of Our City Choir



Cultivating
The Soil

- Gathered to do the work for common good (liturgy) and prayer weekly on Sunday Morning, at the Contemporary Courtyard Service, and at Friday Noon Eucharist
- Refreshed our souls through holy music offered at Evensong and organ recitals
- Tended to our personal spiritual growth through multiple offerings including
 - Weekly Sunday forum
 - Women Together
 - Lent and fall formation series
 - Young adult Bible study
 - Youth formation class
 - Centering prayer group
- Expanded thinking around issues ranging from interfaith dialogue to human sexuality, to the separation of church and state, to theology and philosophy and beyond through classes and discussions hosted by numerous ministries
- Hosted regional and national Episcopal Church events including the 50th anniversary Diocesan Convention and the Vergers' Guild annual conference
- Shared the joys and sorrows of significant milestones including 12 baptisms, 7 weddings, and 12 funerals
- Tended to the ties that bind with care for each other in difficult times through Stephen Ministry
- Celebrated holidays together with special services for Advent, Christmas, Shrove Tuesday, Holy Week, and Easter
